Welcome to Prizmah's Knowledge Center! We are delighted you are here. There are multiple ways to find resources on the Knowledge Center. This user guide will outline them.

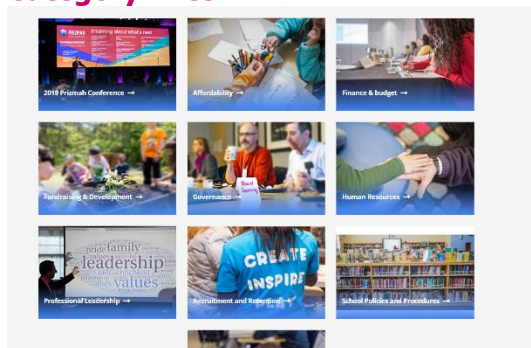
The Search Bar
