A few strategies and apps/tools to break content into small chunks and check for understanding along the way:

- Exit ticket via a Google Form in the chat feature
- [Socrative](#): quick quizzes, polls, exit tickets, etc. in real time
- [Desmos](#): create slides with activities, questions, etc. for students to work through (synchronously or asynchronously). Teacher can pause, check, give feedback. Typically used for math but can be used creatively for much more
- [flipgrid](#): easy and quick video conversation tool
- [edpuzzle](#): embed questions at pause points in video
- [activelylearn](#): Can use their grab+go content or upload your own and embed questions
- [insertlearning](#): Chrome app that allows you to insert content (questions/quizzes) into any website
